Thanks for the suggestion.

Here I would suggest two projects:

1) small RNA sequencing and gene regulation in peanuts, but the similar work (sequencing peanut small RNAs) was published.

2) Another is "Genomic diversity and population structure of cultivated and wild peanuts". We can sequence cultivated peanut (including the widely planting peanuts, Georgia 6G, and 104 USA mini-core germplasm collection which phenotyping, drought tolerance, disease resistance, was done, but genome-wide genotyping is not done) and wild peanut species with GBS.
