Hi Rajeev, Thanks for contacting us. We are in early discussions on a project that is still being defined and then will have to be refined to fit within the limited budgets. One big driver is the need to have impact on the small holder farmer, rather than a general impact on international/develop Ag. At this point we are not sure how much emphasis there will be on genotyping/genomics versus other population development/testing aspects. We also do not yet have a designated PI. Will let you know as this moves forward. -scott
