New Media Contact: I spent some time Friday in an interview with Britt Wray, who has recently completed a book project on de-extinction where she learned about the GBIRD partnership's work. She's currently working on a pitch for a N. American broadcast TV series opportunity focused on synthetic biology and I sense that she thinks there's an episode or two that could focus on our collective efforts.
