Hi All,

I am attempting to bring more organization to the process of moving the GBIRd program forward. As such, I shared the steering committee notes after the meeting. Also, a document of priorities identified by the steering committee & DARPA proposal leaders is attached to this email. We are assuming the team may need to move fast if the proposal is accepted. Also listed in the attachment are needed actions associated with the priorities.
