The past few weeks have been very labor intense with the start of the DARPA funding, reporting requirements and budget/admin needs take hold.

I am working to create a unified system that seamlessly advances the requirements of each of the funding streams of GBIRd (and hopefully they will grow to more than the current two). This will be a subject area of the DC meeting.
